8. Committee Reports

Finance Committee Chair Boyden reported the budget passed as recommended by the board at the district budget meeting on Tuesday.

9. Superintendent's Report

The superintendent reported the results of a student survey collected by My College Options in which thirty percent of Lawrence students said they were interested in a career in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering or Math). Thirty one percent also stated they would be the first member in their family to attend college. Ninety percent of those planning to go to college indicated their preference for a 4-year institution.

Dr. Baker noted the high school concert will be the last of the district spring concerts which will be held on Monday, May 21 at the Williamson Auditorium.

Superintendent relayed that a recent state report on adult education skills indicated on high levels of achievement.

Dr. Baker noted that he had asked the operations department the day before to check all exterior locked doors in all school buildings. All doors except two that were kept open by teachers were locked and secured appropriately. School administrators dealt with the two exceptions. Dr. Baker commended Ms. Bracket for following up with this check by creating a format for daily checks by custodians in all schools.

Dr. Baker noted the Mid Maine Technical Center's recognition night will be held on Thursday at the Williamson Auditorium.

Principal Lee reported Fairfield Primary held a Father Daughter Dance on May 4. Albion Elementary PTA held a Mother's Day Bazaar on May 11. Albion also held the Mason's Bikes for Books Celebration. One lucky boy and girl in every grade received a bike after earning tickets in the reading challenge. An extra bike was awarded by the staff after looking at the Habits of Work – bestowing a bike to a student that worked hard and didn't give up.

Principal Gordon reported 26 Clinton students attended the Colby Cares for Kids BBQ on Friday. This annual event is for students who have mentors from Colby.

Principal Boynton reported the LJH held a 'campus clean-up' in front of the junior high. The JHS spring concert was held May 16.
